

# Memorandum

SUBJECT:

Bob Herrema in Senator Weicker's office called to say that Senator Weicker and some members of his staff propose to go see the FBI and sit with some agents while the agents go through the files containing the 1500 requests and approximately 300,000 items in response that Wannell informed me were involved in Weicker's letters to Ruckelshaus and Cox.

I said that I assumed that no action by us was required at this time and Mr. Herrema said that was so although we would probably be hearing from the FBI. I said that I did not know how the FBI would react to the procedures Senator Weicker proposed and since I did not know what was in the files I did not know what our reaction would be to specific requests although we were certainly anxious to cooperate.
