In Re: Complaint of Geoffrey Shepard (10/3/21)

This eleventh letter is submitted in furtherance of my Complaint of Attorney Misconduct, which was filed electronically on October 3, 2021.

I continue to be disappointed that almost a year has passed and I have neither heard back from your office as to your progress in investigating my complaint, nor been invited to make an in-person presentation. Watergate, as you must know, is a hugely complex story and I fear you will miss the significance of some issues, if you don't see them in context.

With that in mind, I'm writing to let you know about the virtual symposium on September 15th, "Revealing Documents from the Watergate Prosecutions," being hosted by The Federalist Society and featuring distinguished federal judges, law professors and practitioners discussing the significance of some dozen internal prosecutorial documents I've uncovered from the Watergate Special Prosecution Force.

The documents and other background materials are already posted on their website. Registering lawyers can get up to three hours of Ethics CLE credits from watching. <https://fedsoc.org/events/revealing-documents-from-the-watergate-prosecutions>.

It is many of these same documents which have also been the subject of my prior Complaints of Attorney Misconduct, which have been submitted to OPR over the past year.

While not the subject of the Federalist Society symposium, the parallels of what is going on today with President Trump and his former associates cannot be ignored.

Surely, OPR will undertake a thorough review of prosecutorial abuses from the Watergate era, covered up by the improper removal of official government records by those same prosecutors, and provide the written report so clearly promised on your website.
